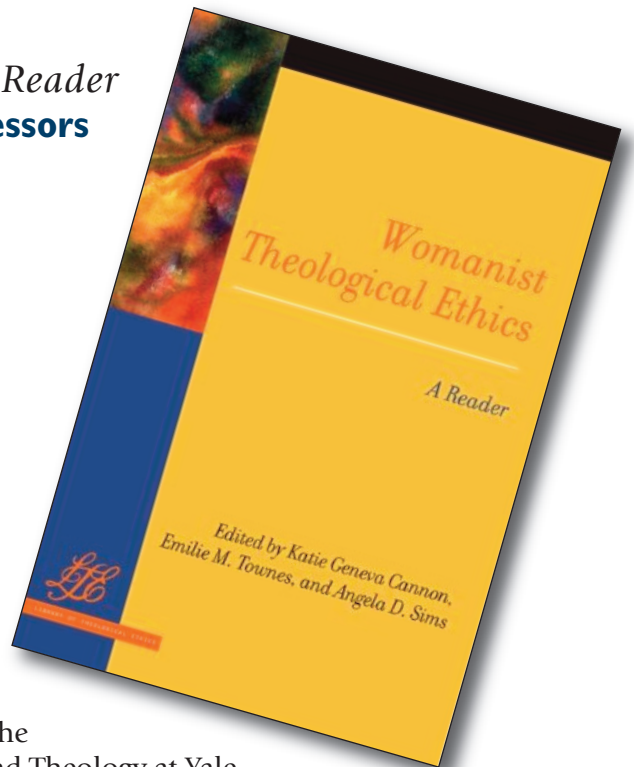

Katie Geneva Cannon is the Annie Scales Rogers Professor of Christian Ethics at Union Presbyterian Seminary in Richmond, VA, and the author of *Katie's Canon: Womanism and the Soul of the Black Community* and *Black Womanist Ethics*. She is the recipient of the 2011 Excellence in Teaching award of the American Academy of Religion (AAR).

Emilie M. Townes is associate dean of academic affairs and the Andrew W. Mellon Professor of African American Religion and Theology at Yale Divinity School. The author or editor of several publications, she is a former president of the American Academy of Religion.

Angela D. Sims is assistant professor of ethics and Black Church studies at Saint Paul School of Theology in Kansas City, MO, and the author of *Ethical Complications of Lynching: Ida B. Well's Interrogation of American Terror*. She is a 2008 Ph.D. graduate of Union-PSCE.
